

Wellspring for Women Volunteer Opportunities

- 1) **Connection Class (life skills) teacher:** Connection Class teachers are designed to EQUIP Wellspring Living participants with the necessary skills for life. Connection classes are split into 3 tracks: Home Connection, Career Connection and Body Soul and Spirit Connection. These classes teach everything from cooking and home organization to conflict management and personal finances. Classes are offered Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday at 1:00. Teachers are divided into a rotating schedule by topic and availability. - 2) **Store Volunteer:** Store Volunteers work in our local resale/thrift stores, assisting with sorting, pricing, merchandizing, clerks and cleaning. Most volunteers work one 4 hour shift a week on a committed basis. Shifts run 9am-1pm and 1pm-5pm, Monday through Saturday. We have a store in Peachtree City (770.632.1788) and Duluth (770.632.3166).
- 3) **On Call Heroes:** The Wellspring Living Home is always in need of honey-do helpers who can be on call for various home maintenance needs: yard work, electrical issues, plumbing, pool maintenance, etc. If you are interested in being added to the On Call Heroes list for Duluth, contact Hannah Rinehart at hrinehart@wellspringliving.org or call our ministry number at 404.427.3100.

We need men and women on a rotating schedule that would be willing to come out on Saturdays and assist with home maintenance and yard work. (We can use individuals or groups of up to 20.)

- 4) **Furniture Pickup Crews:** These teams are scheduled one Saturday a month to help with picking up furniture donations for The Wellspring Store. At least one or two on the team must own a vehicle that can transport large furniture. If you are interested in helping with this, please call 770.632.1788.
- 5) **Parties for the Girls:** This is a time when women can come to the Wellspring home to interact with the women on a more casual level. We have had Discipleship or Bible study groups come and bring dinner, do a movie night, or spa night. These are great times of pampering the women and showing them Christ's love.
- 6) **Birthday Boxes:** Put together all items necessary to throw a Birthday Party!
